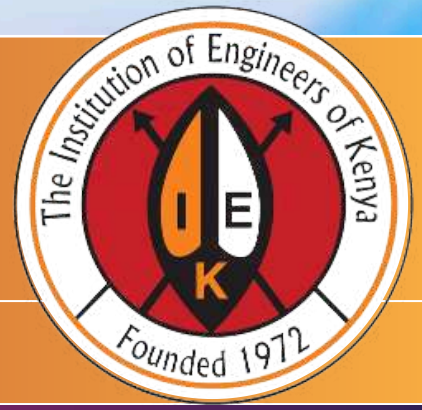

Held on 29th and 30th May 2025, the two-day convention brought together leading female voices in the engineering field under the theme: "Engineering Excellence in Service Delivery." The landmark event marked a critical step forward in recognizing and celebrating the role of women in engineering.

The serene shores of Lake Naivasha provided a fitting backdrop for powerful keynote speeches, technical sessions, and spirited networking among seasoned professionals, young engineers, students, and policymakers.

### High-Level Guests and Powerful Messages

Day one of the convention was punctuated by a glamorous cowgirl-themed gala dinner on the evening of 29th May, featuring two celebrated Kenyan women as Chief Guests.

Dr. Ida Betty Odinga, a trailblazing business executive and Managing Director of East Africa Spectre Ltd, addressed the attendees with a rousing speech on resilience and leadership.

She was joined by Hon. Harriet Chiggai, the Presidential Advisor on Women's Rights, who challenged women engineers to embrace innovation and take up leadership roles in public service and infrastructure development.

On the second day, the convention was graced by Hon. Irene Mayaka, Nominated Member of Parliament and vocal advocate for youth and women's empowerment. Hon. Mayaka applauded IEK's commitment to bridging gender gaps in STEM.
